


### D. Installation steps




**Main Cabinet Installation:**  
Install the main cabinet by aligning it with the wall mounting points. Secure the cabinet to the wall using the provided screws through the designated mounting holes.

**Faucet Installation:**  
Install the faucet on the basin and ensure all water connections are properly tightened to prevent water leakage. Secure the faucet firmly in place without over-tightening, which could damage the connections or cause misalignment.




**Basin Sealing:**  
Apply sealant around the gap between the basin and the vanity top to create a watertight seal and prevent water damage.

**Hot and Cold Water Pipe Installation:**  
Connect and tighten all water supply hoses and inlet pipes to prevent water leakage. Ensure the hot and cold water pipe connections correspond correctly to the faucet's hot and cold controls (hot water to the left side, cold water to the right side).

**IMPORTANT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS MUST BE EXECUTED:**

**Cleaning Requirements:** Do not use acidic or alkaline cleaning agents on this vanity. Many commercial cleaners contain abrasives and harsh chemicals that can damage stainless steel, enamel, plated, or plastic surfaces. Clean only with mild detergent or soap solution, rinse thoroughly, and wipe dry with a clean cloth. Clean electric mirrors with a suede cloth for optimal performance.

**Moisture and Ventilation:** Maintain good bathroom ventilation at all times by keeping windows and doors open when possible to prevent moisture buildup. Although the cabinet has moisture-resistant treatment, never allow water to directly contact or splash onto cabinet surfaces, and immediately dry any areas that become wet or humid.

**Regular Maintenance:** Clean door panels regularly with a soft cloth and wipe away moisture after bathing to keep panels dry. This will help maintain the cabinet's appearance and prevent water damage over time.

**Usage Restrictions:** Never sit on, lean against, or step on the washbasin cabinet during use, as this can cause damage or injury. The cabinet is designed to support only its intended load and normal bathroom accessories.
